### Practical Task

- Task 1: Ballet Barre

Please ensure you are appropriately dressed and groomed for a ballet class. We would like you to record yourself in 'one take' performing all three exercises. There is no need to perform the exercises on both sides. Recordings must be shot in landscape orientation.

- Adage - A whole new world

- Task 2: Jazz Routine

We would like you to record yourself in 'one take' performing the routine.

Music is 'Underground' from Memphis the Musical. Task 3: Dance

- Task 3: Choreographed Solo

As part of the audition process for the BTEC Dance course you will be required to perform a Solo of no less than two minutes. We will of course be assessing your technical skills, but as this a performance course we need to see that you can 'communicate' to an audience. We want to see your personality shine through in the performance of your solo. We want to see your drive and passion and love of dance.

Top tips for your solo...

- Select a piece of music and you love and can connect to, bear in mind the music doesn't always have to have lyrics.
- Your solo must include some technical steps eg, Kicks, turns, jumps (as much as you have the space)
- Please do incorporate your own style and expression into your solo
- You may send us an appropriate solo that has been recorded in a studio before the Covid-19 pandemic as long as it meets the requirements above.
- Do not worry if you do not have much room to record your solo. Just do you best under the circumstances and use the space you have to the best of your ability.

***\*Please ensure that you record your solo in a safe space, remove all breakable objects from around you. Please make sure that your music can be clearly heard on the recording.***

- Why you want to study on the Level 3 Dance Btec?
- What is your previous Dance experience or background?
- What ignited your passion for Dance?
- Are there any Dance practitioners that have heavily influenced you/your style/passion for the subject?
